The middle column is the one to plan around — it is what you pay in a normal trimester. The first trimester is higher on every programme except ICT, and the reason is directly below.

Why the first trimester is higher. Registration, caution money (refundable), uniform/lab coat, the medical examination on admission and the Hepatitis B vaccine are charged **once**, at the start. From the second trimester the bill settles to the standard figure. The Diploma in ICT is the exception — its fee barely moves across the whole course.

Meals and boarding are **not** included in any figure on this page. See "Meals and accommodation" below.

All figures are **indicative — 2026 approved structure; confirm with the Finance Office**. Intakes run at the start of every trimester — January, March, May and September; the next is **1 September 2026** for every programme.

Bridging tuition is 10% below Outspan rates. Meals and boarding for bridging students are charged monthly, not per trimester: meals KES 3,000 per month, boarding KES 5,700 per month.

Meals and accommodation are not in the fee

Every figure on this page is tuition and college charges only. Meals and boarding are optional, charged on top, and only if the student takes them.

Pay only to Paybill 9583518. We will never ask you to send fees to a personal phone number, a till, or any other paybill. If someone asks you to, it is not us — call the college on +254 718 322 222 before you send anything.

Payment rules

- ✓ Fees must be cleared by the end of the 2nd month of each trimester. Failure to clear bars a student from block exams and assessments.
- ✓ Fees once paid are not refundable after the trimester has commenced.
- ✓ Use the learner's name as the account number so the payment reaches the right student.
- ✓ Exam and assessment fees are payable as communicated by the relevant examination body.
- ✓ The college may adjust fees; students and parents will be informed.

- ✓ KCPE certificate

Intakes run at the start of every trimester — January, March, May and September; the next is **1 September 2026** for every programme.

Minimum KCSE entry grades: **Diploma in Nursing C** (plus subject minimums — see the nursing page) · **DPOTT and Diploma in ICT C** · **Certificate in Perioperative Theatre Technology and Health Services Support D** · **Care Giver II D** · **Bridging takes any grade**. Application deadlines are **TBC** — call or WhatsApp us with your KCSE slip and we will tell you where you stand today.

The questions we are asked most

If your question is not answered here, call or WhatsApp us — but most of the time it is here.

Why is the first trimester more expensive?

Registration, caution money (refundable), uniform/lab coat, the medical examination on admission and the Hepatitis B vaccine are charged once, at the start. From the second trimester you pay the standard figure.

When is the next intake?

1 September 2026 — the same date for every programme, in both schools.

How do I pay?

M-Pesa Paybill 9583518, using the **learner's name** as the account number. Keep the confirmation SMS. Never send fees to a personal number — only to this paybill.

When must fees be paid?

Each trimester's fees must be cleared by the end of that trimester's second month. Unpaid fees bar a student from block exams and assessments.

Can I pay in instalments?

The rule is that each trimester is cleared by the end of its second month. How you get there is between you and the Finance Office — speak to them about a payment plan.

Is caution money refundable?

Yes. It is a one-off deposit charged in the first trimester and it is refundable.

Are meals and accommodation included?

No. Both are optional and charged on top: meals KES 7,500 per trimester for day scholars, boarding KES 22,500 per trimester. For bridging students it is KES 3,000 and KES 5,700 per month.

Is there an application fee?

No. Enquiring and applying cost nothing.

What documents do I bring?

Originals only, and the same list for every programme — it is set out in full on the apply page.

All figures are **indicative** — **2026 approved structure; confirm with the Finance Office**.
